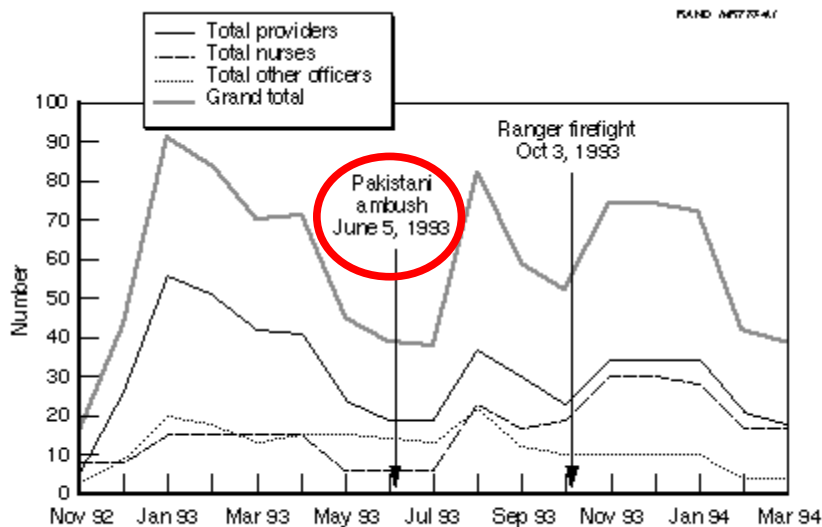
Join us in the Nevada Desert for a two day operation. This will be a theatrical re-enactment involving the 3rd FORCECON/4th SCAMP SOC unit, the 24th Marine Expeditionary Unit (SOC), and the well trained Pakistani Military force. The operation will include elements of reconnaissance, ambush, and recovery operations.

[Loosely based on a military support/medical mission on June 5th, 1993 in Somalia]

Scenario:

When clan violence in 1992 threatened international relief efforts in Somalia, a U.S.-led coalition was sent in to provide relief for the thousands of Somalis who were caught in the crossfire of a deadly civil war.

Providing care to Somali nationals (refugees) or to relief workers operating within the theater was not part of this medical mission.[3]Neither was getting involved in the actual humanitarian relief activities within the various sectors--that was to be the purview of the NGOs.[4] In theory, all the U.S. military's medical resources were to go in support of U.S. forces during this operation.



During deliveries of medical supplies to outlying villages, small medical detachments have encountered hostiles. To this date no med-team has sustained casualties. In future SOCOM has ordered the following upgrades to the medical assistance program: increased security for the med-teams will be provided by small Special Forces detachments and their work will be documented by a combat photographer.
